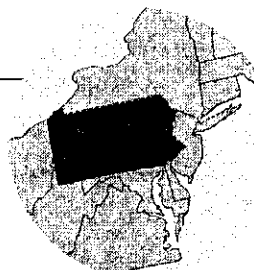

The Lantern Project is a new, independent political organization formed under Section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code. Its aim is to expose right-wing public officials, as extremists, rather than the pillars of mainstream, middle-American values they claim to be.

The Lantern Project's current, principal focus is Pennsylvania's U.S. Senator Rick Santorum. The Lantern Project plans to launch an effective multi-media communications campaign to expose Santorum's record, positions, statements and agenda.

We believe that Rick Santorum has failed to use his position as a U.S. Senator to improve the lives of most Americans, so our goal is simple: To shine a light on the facts about Rick Santorum's extreme positions, failed policies and hypocritical statements -- and let the facts speak for themselves.

Funding an aggressive media campaign in Pennsylvania designed to expose Rick Santorum using a combination of paid communications vehicles (broadcast and cable TV, radio, the Internet, direct mail, and phones) is so crucial, we can not afford to wait another day.

Over the next few months, The Lantern Project will put \$5-10 million behind its communications campaign. In order to achieve this level of funding, we are forming partnerships with individuals, corporations and organizations from across the country who care about the impact extremist politicians, such as Senator Santorum, have on U.S. public policy and culture and who are ready and willing to fight

This is the only project of its kind. National advocacy groups are planning programs in Pennsylvania, focusing on Senator Santorum's outrageous positions on a number of issues. But The Lantern Project is the only organization building a coalition of progressive partners to expose Santorum's backward view of the world and the danger it poses to the country.
